Hi to everyone at Harrison Pointe,

COVID-19 is the infectious disease caused by the most recently discovered Coronavirus. This new virus and disease were unknown before the outbreak began in Wuhan, China, in December 2019.

Amid the Coronaviruses worldwide, there have been three dozen cases now confirmed in BC and one fatality. With that being said, we would like to take extra precautions effective immediately.

**If you or someone close to you has travelled to an affected community, boarded a plane, been on a cruise ship or has had a recent hospital visit in the last couple of days we are asking you to self-isolate (in suite) for up to 14 days and for visitors to refrain from coming into our community for the same allotted time.**

**All non-urgent appointments should be put on hold or scheduled for a later date.**

**If you are at any time uncertain if you should visit, please call ahead and someone here will assist you.**

If you have any symptoms such as fever, cough, wheezing or shortness of breath, you should see a doctor immediately.

The virus has now hit close to home so please remember that the best way to stop the spread of COVID-19 is to continue taking these precautions and to self-isolate and call your doctor if you “think” you have these symptoms.

Reduce your chances of being infected or spreading COVID-19 by taking some simple precautions:

- Regularly and thoroughly clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or wash them with soap and water.
- Maintain at least 1 metre (3 feet) distance between yourself and anyone who is coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.
- Cover your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze. Then dispose of the used tissue immediately.
- Stay home if you feel unwell. If you have a fever, cough and difficulty breathing, seek medical attention and call in advance.
- Continue to clean and sanitize your environment daily (surfaces, doorknobs, phone)

At this time we encourage all kind gestures, such as hugging and hand shaking to be put on hold until further notice.

**Also, at any point, if this virus comes in to Langley or grows rapidly; Harrison Pointe will be placed on a full lockdown.**
