Tough times call for tough measures.

We have decided to take the extraordinary measure and close Harrison Pointe to residents leaving with the exception of medical appointments and local walks and scooter rides. We can't prohibit you from leaving. We **can** prohibit you from re-entering this facility under the Community Care and Assisted Living Act.

Do not visit coffee shops, libraries or use public transit (**the BIG ONE**), etc. If you require purchases from a store, have a loved one make your purchase and deliver it to our reception, where we will meet them and safely deliver the supplies to your suite.

Feel free to go anywhere in the building and partake in activities, but refrain from leaving because you risk the chance of introducing the virus to the building upon return. We realize that we have the problem that staff go back and forth to home and work. We have already had 5 staff self quarantine themselves at their home on our order because of a possibility that they may have been close to someone who had border crossed or taken a flight, just to be extra cautious. We are being as vigilant as we can. But no plan will be perfect. To be clear, **THERE ARE NO CASES OF COVID-19** at Harrison Pointe. We will do everything in our power to keep it that way.

BUT WE NEED YOUR HELP TO DO SO.

We are intimately aware that this will cause frustration, boredom and anger. Therefore, several staff members are meeting tomorrow morning to come up with a new activity calendar that can keep you active within Harrison Pointe.
