Dear Residents,

As you are likely aware, COVID-19 is an infectious disease that is spreading throughout the world, and more cases are being discovered in B.C. now as well. The World Health Organization has now declared this a pandemic.

In order to mitigate the risks to you, we have closed Harrison Landing to any unnecessary visitors. This includes family and friends for the time being. We are also asking all residents to stay at Harrison Landing, and not go out into the community. We are taking these precautions in order to keep you as safe as possible. We want to prevent COVID-19 from entering Harrison Landing, and the only way we can do this is to limit who comes in and out of the building. If you do need to leave the building, please be aware that you will be under quarantine for 14 days when you return. We request that no one leaves the building unless it is absolutely necessary.

We would also like to assure you that we are monitoring staff as well, and staff are following social distancing guidelines outside of work. Harrison Landing staff, and Fraser Health Care Aides, provide essential services to our residents. As such they will continue to come to the building, but will be using extra precautions. We will be closely monitoring the situation.

If you feel that you have any symptoms of COVID-19 such as a fever, cough, shortness of breath, aches, or any other concerns – please call the front desk at 604-530-7075 and someone will come to check on you. The first course of action is not to go to the hospital. After an assessment by Harrison Landing staff, we would assist you in getting access to a test to determine if you have the virus. At this time, routine testing is not available. It is only available for those that are displaying symptoms of COVID-19, as determined by a health professional.

We will continue to keep you updated at least weekly, as the situation is evolving. Our top priority is keeping our residents safe, and we will do what we can to keep you happy and comfortable while we all weather this storm together.

Please remember, thorough hand washing is one of the best ways to prevent the spread of illness. Please also refrain from touching your face, or coming into very close contact with one another.
