Hi All:

I know that we are all getting antsy and anxious waiting for the Fraser Health Authority to lift their restrictions on us. I spoke with the Director, LTC-AL COVID Special Assignment, who reports directly to the Medical Health Officer and she has assured me that she sees no problem with having our restrictions lifted and believes that will happen first thing tomorrow morning. I will let everyone know as soon as I know.

I sincerely apologize for this delay. They are incredibly busy.

This weekend saw 17 deaths and 1933 new cases over the weekend in B.C., the majority of those in the Fraser Health Authority.

We plead with you to be careful when re-entering the community. Masks are now mandatory in any public place, including elevators, hallways and common areas at Harrison Pointe. Free masks are available at reception, so just ask please.

Vicki has started to decorate for Christmas and although Christmas will look a lot different this year, we will celebrate and we will share good times together. We had hoped to have the decorations completed for when you were all out but we won't quite be there.

I will send out a letter as soon as I have spoken to the Medical Health Officer in the morning.
