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Hi All:

We had what will most likely be our last inspection by Fraser Health today. All is good. Unfortunately, the BC Centre for Disease Control (BCCDC) advised us this evening that they will not be able to provide us with swabs until tomorrow due to the huge numbers of cases out there in the Fraser Health Authority. That means that we will not be able to swab test until Friday now. My apologies but this is out of our control.

Our Outbreak Response Lead agrees with our assertion that it is highly unlikely that we will see another positive in this mass swabbing because no one has come in contact with anyone else (other than staff) for the past 22 days. So, short of someone using a fake nose during the last swabbing or a "false negative" from the BCCDC when they reviewed the swabs on November 17th (which does happen), we should be in great shape!

Staff and I would like to thank all of you for being so patient and understanding during the past 3 weeks. You are truly a remarkable group of people and we respect and admire your tenacity during these long periods of isolation, which are not good for mental nor physical wellbeing.

I told Dawn that we should have a huge party the day we are back to normal but I was told that I would be looking for a new care team if I did that, so I guess that won't be happening! Besides, at this point it would be illegal!

I neglected to let everyone know that we would be back doing full housekeeping beginning yesterday and I apologize for that omission. Tomorrow will be 3rd Floor and Friday will be 1st and 2nd Floors, as usual.

Again, thank you for your continued patience.
