Hello Residents and families,

As we all keep hearing on the news, Covid-19 cases are increasing dramatically in the Fraser Health Region. So far we have managed to keep it out of Harrison Landing, but we must continue to be vigilant. We must all work together to keep Harrison Landing safe.

Therefore, we have some requests for our Harrison Landing community:

-Please, try to go out only for essential medical appointments, and at this time do NOT also have a visit with family members, or make unnecessary stops around town. Please go directly to your appointment (wearing a mask and following all precautions), and come directly back to Harrison Landing. This will significantly reduce your risk of exposure to Covid-19 if you must go out. If you just go to a medical appointment, then you are only required to wear a mask for 7 days afterwards. If you are out for a long period of time, and going to many places, then you will need to be quarantined to your room for 14 days. Please understand, this is to protect the health of all the residents who live here. Covid-19 can spread very quickly.

You can still have a visit with a family member here at Harrison Landing, in the designated area. Please call reception to make an appointment. You can also book your December visit in advance. We will do our best to accommodate Christmas visiting, but please remember we do need to abide by the Fraser Health guidelines, and of course there are limits to how many visits we can manage in a day. Please call reception if you have any questions about booking a visit. Booking in advance will give us time to plan, and allow for as many visits as possible.

-We would also like to request that you continue to use hand sanitizer frequently when moving about the building. You are all excellent at using it as you are entering the dining room – please remember to use it as you are exiting as well! Thank you so much for your cooperation!

-It is a good idea to wear a mask (if you can tolerate it) when you are in close quarters with another resident. For example, in the elevators, and laundry rooms. And it is certainly not a bad idea to wear them in all common areas. Masks are now required for the general public in all indoor public spaces. This regulation does not apply to our residents, as this is your home, however it could add a layer of protection to reduce transmission of the virus, if it were to enter our premises. If you would like a mask please ask a staff member, we would be happy to provide you with one.

To summarize: Please keep outings to necessary appointments, please wash and sanitize your hands frequently, and masks are optional for all residents.
