Hi Everyone:

I am pleased to report that we achieved 100% NEGATIVE results on this last PPT swabbing! Fraser Health has said that we will come off of the outbreak list this weekend, probably Sunday.

This doesn't affect the Provincial Health Officer's December 9th order that prohibits anyone from going to another person's home or having visitors at your home, currently until midnight, January 8th.

This has been a difficult virus to overcome completely. So that we can stay virus free, we ask that, **once we have been taken off the outbreak list this weekend**, you restrict your time in the community. Stay away from restaurants and areas where people gather, where social distancing cannot be maintained, as much as possible, and staff will continue to do so as well. Wear a mask. It is the law that you must wear a mask in all public places, which include Harrison Pointe elevators, hallways and common areas, unless you are eating. Replace your mask with a fresh one every second day or, if you have a cloth mask, wash it in your sink each evening. The laundry rooms remain closed to residents until the outbreak is declared over.

Remember, this news means that the declaration of the outbreak being over and a return to our normal will happen this weekend – **IT ISN'T HAPPENING TODAY**. Today's news paves the way for the outbreak to be over this weekend, **not today**.

We will be getting the dining room back in service after the outbreak has been declared over.

CHRISTMAS PRESENTS:

If you wrap your loved one's presents, put them in a plastic bag with their name marked on it and leave them with reception, we will carefully and lightly spray the wrap and then deliver them to the resident.
