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Hi All:

December 8, 2020

We have received all of the results from Saturday's swabbing. The results are coming in late now, as they are swabbing thousands of people per day.

The results of the swabbing are on the reverse of this page. In summary, no staff tested positive, one resident tested positive and 4 residents had "Invalid – Poor Sample Quality" results and have been retested this evening. We are also retesting the one positive resident in the hope that it was a false positive, although that is highly unlikely.

These results were extremely discouraging to me until I had the ability to see them in a positive light. Rather than focus on the fact that one more resident has been infected with this virus (who currently is showing no symptoms), I realized what this really tells us. We know today that all 100% of staff and 99.3% of residents at Harrison Pointe are COVID-19 free.

How that translates into what the Fraser Health Authority will tell us, I can't tell you this evening and I apologize for that. I have been in lengthy discussions today and have brought up many factors: 99 of you are Independent Living and are not under the umbrella of the Assisted Living Registrar; the effects of isolation are not conducive to good mental well-being; we are now in very little danger as all residents and staff have recovered, with the exception of the one new case, who is quarantined, etc.....

I feel that we are in excellent shape. We will get the results from these 5 swabs, hopefully by early Thursday morning. Once submitted to FHA, we will be able to find out what rules they have in store for us.

We have gained one argument in this and that is that we have been approved for re-opening the visitors' area. Reception will begin taking reservations for visits with your loved ones tomorrow at 1:00 pm, to begin on Thursday, Dec 10th.

The only saving grace – comfort, what have you, right now is that everyone in B.C. is under basically the same restrictions with respect to visitors and community conduct.

We are all concerned about Christmas visits and time with family. We have a plan that we are working on to make sure that this can happen for you and will finalize it tomorrow and include





it in tomorrow night's update.

Again, I apologize that the results took so long to come in, but we have no control over that.

Two of those residents wanted to be included in this swabbing and both tested NEGATIVE.

The one POSITIVE resident from this swabbing had last come in contact with our previous POSITIVE staff member (housekeeper) on November 25, 2020. Our staff member tested POSITIVE on November 27, 2020.

New POSITIVE resident has been in quarantine since October 20th and poses no threat to other residents.
